Instructions to the Voter

- To vote your ballot, completely fill the oval beside your candidate of choice using black or blue pen.
- To cast a Write-In vote for candidate whose name does not appear on the ballot, fill the oval beside the "Write-In" and print or stamp a candidate's name in the space provided.
- **Do not** select more candidates than permitted in each contest.
- **Do not** affix Write-In stickers or labels to your ballot, which can damage the ballot scanning equipment.
- **Do not** attempt to erase or cross out a mistake; instead, request a new ballot.



If you are unable to return your voted Absentee or Mail-In Ballot by the deadline, you may only vote a Provisional Ballot at your polling place on Election Day, unless you surrender your Absentee or Mail-In Ballot and envelope to the Judge of Elections to be voided to vote by regular ballot.
